SHOOTS IN SPAIN - POST COVID19 STATUS

Spain has started this de-escalation process to a new normality. The initial and preliminary phase will start on the 4th of May and will go until the end of June approximately. All these phases could vary in length and procedures depending how the key indicators evolve in the following weeks.

The whole process will take a total of 8 weeks, and gradually will start opening different industries and territories within the country.

Different measures will need to be taken into consideration when we go back to productions and shoots. The different protocols that have initiated different associations, like the Spanish association of advertising producers or Secuoya TV, have in common that hygienic protocols will need to be applied into all shoots, which eventually will have a repercussion in the production budgets, as well as on shooting schedules, reducing the amount of time we have available for shooting.

We are still waiting to hear an official protocol from state or local authorities, which eventually could change this initial approach to production, and film shoots.

Nevertheless, all protocols will depend in how we de-escalate through the different phases.

There is no official production guideline update, other than what we get from producers associations or NHS office.

PHASES TO NEW NORMALITY



ISLANDS:
 • Formentera
 • La Gomera
 • El Hierro
 • La Graciosa
 Straight to phase 1

2 Weeks
 If all indicators are good.

Estimated **8 weeks** to finalise all phases.

Phase 0 (4-10 May)

Phase 1 (11 May to 24th May)

Phase 2 (25th of May to June 7th)

Phase 3 (June 8th to June 22nd apro.)

- Hairdressers and other businesses that offer service by appointment can reopen.
- Restaurants can offer take-away services.
- Professional sports leagues will go back to training.
- Short walks and individual sporting activities allowed starting on 2 May.

- All provinces that meet the requirements will move to phase 1 on 11 May, except for three islands in the Canaries archipelago - La Gomera, El Hierro and La Graciosa - and the Balearic island of Formentera, where phase 1 begins on 4 May as an exception.
- Small businesses to reopen under strict safety conditions.
- Bars and restaurants can reopen their terraces with no more than 30% occupation.
- Hotels and other tourist accommodation can reopen, excluding common areas.
- Shops and other service providers must set aside preferential times for customers aged over 65 to visit.
- Places of worship will also be reopened, limiting the capacity to one third.

- Theatres and cinemas to reopen, filling no more than a third of their capacity.
- Cultural centres such as art galleries and museums will reopen, again operating only at a third of regular capacity.
- Places of worship will increase their capacity to 50%.
- Hunting and sport-fishing will be allowed.
- Some schools will reopen, though most will stay closed until September.

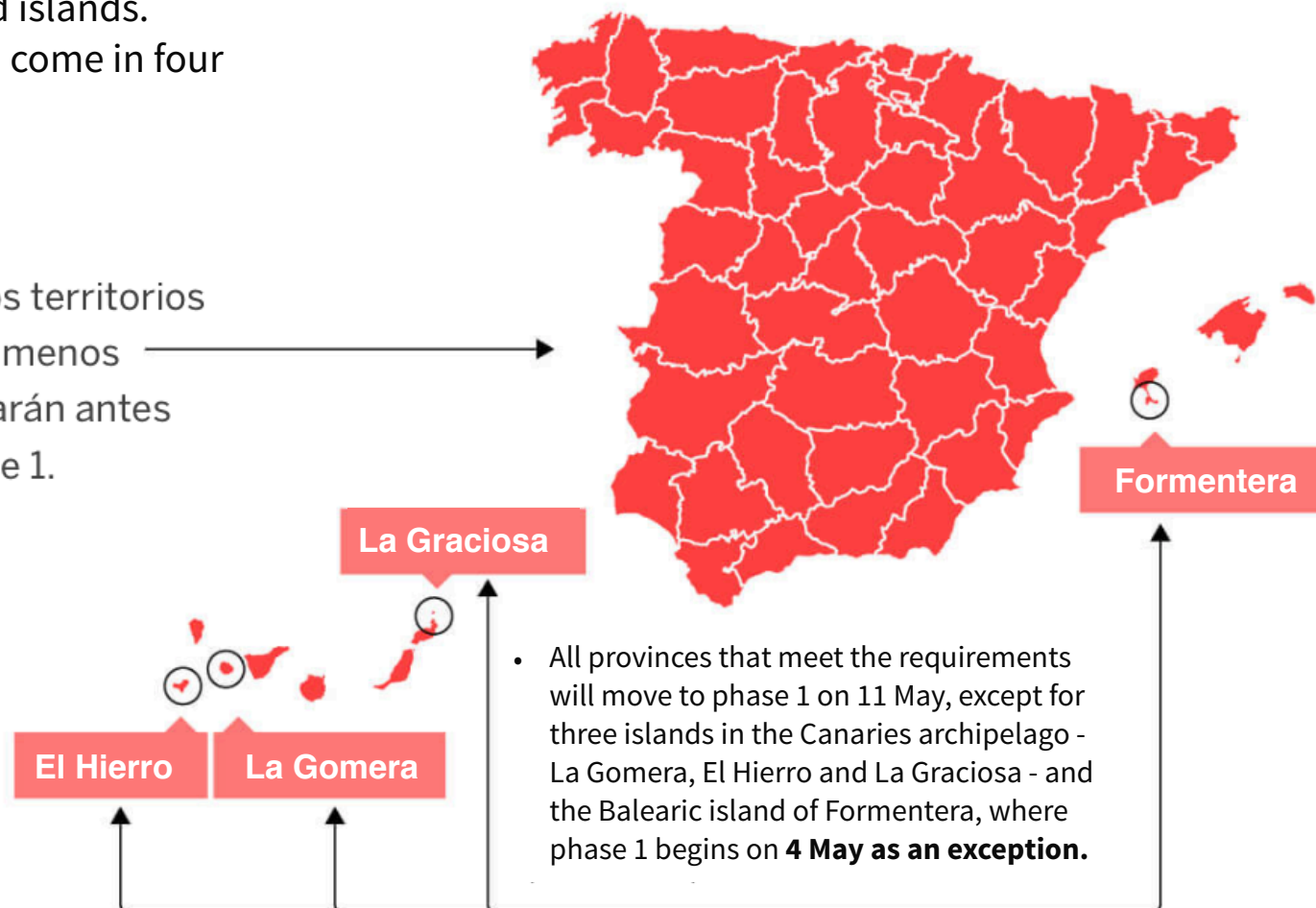
- Shops will be allowed to open at half capacity with distancing of two meters between clients.
- Restrictions on restaurants and bars will be further loosened.
- Opening of beaches.

GEOGRAPHICAL SCOPE

The mobility phases will apply to provinces and islands.

De-escalation will be asymmetric and without communication between provinces and islands. Territorial mobility will come in four phases.

ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS

- **What dates will the lockdowns and preventative measures be lifted in Spain?**

End of Phase 3 - Towards the end of June. Approximately around week of June 22nd

- **Are there phases to the end of the lockdown strategy and the key dates?**

Yes, 4 Phases (from 0 to 3 inclusive)

4-10 May	Phase 0
11- 24 May	Phase 1
25th May to June 7th	Phase 2
8- 22nd June	Phase 3

- **What date could we reasonably consider carrying out this idea in Spain?**

We can start requesting permits from May 11th. Then we would need, depending on the permit we would need to allow around 1-2 weeks for permit approval.

- **When will we be able to book a studio? Dates and measures?**

We can start booking a Studio from May 11th on. That is the Go Ahead date the public administration has opening their services. Safety Measure would need to take in place based on the Protocol Spanish APA (APCP).

- **Can permits be obtained to take photos on the street and in what Cities?**

Not until May the 11th. Then we would need at least 1 week time for permit approval and clearance. Always locally with very limited mobility with in the province.

- **What is the maximum number of people that we can bring together in a single space?**

We are still waiting to hear from official authorities, but we apparently we would be able to have a max of 50 people, if we are able to comply with security measures, and the chosen locations admits to have 2 meters distance between workers. Obviously, some of the crew will need to be closer than others, for such situations we will provide with additional security equipment.

- **Can people move between cities within the same country now, if not then when?**

Mobility will vary between different regions depending on how good indicators evolve. For the moment there is **no mobility between different provinces**, and this will start on May the 11th. To be Confirmed, since there are local authorities in different states which vary in their policy to this respect.

- **Can you send us a link to the governing body for the entertainment industry where we can continue to check in on status moving forwards?**

There is no official production guideline update, other than what we get from producers associations or NHS office.

SPAIN - published 23.04.2020

Passengers are not allowed to enter Spain.

This does not apply to:

- a) Passengers arriving from Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Czechia, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland (Rep.), Italy, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Sweden or Switzerland;
- b) Nationals of Spain and their immediate family members;
- c) Passengers travelling to their place of residency within the European Union and their immediate family members;
- d) Passengers travelling to their place of residency in Andorra, Iceland, Norway or Switzerland;
- e) Passengers with a long-term visa issued by a Schengen Member State, who go directly to their country of residence;
- f) Healthcare or elderly care professionals in the performance of their duties;
- g) Diplomats, international organisations, military personnel and members of humanitarian organisations in the performance of their duties;
- h) People traveling for imperative family reasons duly accredited;
- i) Persons who document reasons of force majeure or situation of need, or whose entry is permitted for humanitarian reasons.
